

These Terms and Conditions govern the *Award's Outcomes Research's* Free Prize Draw. The Free Prize Draw is promoted by the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Foundation of 7-11 St Matthew Street, London, SW1P 2JT ("the Foundation").

### **Conditions of Entry**

1. By entering the Prize Draw, you agree to the provisions of these Terms and Conditions and to comply fully with them.
2. The Prize Draw is only open to 14 to 18 year olds who complete the surveys of the Outcomes Research of the Foundation.
3. To enter the Prize Draw you must complete all questions of both pre- and post-surveys of the Outcomes Research of the Foundation and submit your name and email address in the set time frame given in the email containing the post-survey link. No purchase is necessary. If you have any questions about how to enter or in connection with the Prize Draw, please email [Melek.De-Wint@intaward.org](mailto:Melek.De-Wint@intaward.org) with "Outcomes Research Prize Draw" in the subject line.
4. Only one entry per person is permitted. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
5. The Prize Draw commences on 1 September 2016 and ends on 31 August 2017.
6. Only complete entries received before the closing date will be accepted. The Foundation accepts no responsibility for any entries that are lost, incomplete, illegible, corrupted or fail to reach it by the Closing Date for any reason. Proof of submission is not proof of receipt.
7. By entering the Prize Draw you confirm to the Foundation that all information submitted by you is correct and that you have complied fully with these Terms and Conditions. The Foundation reserves the right to verify the eligibility of entrants. Automated entries and entries via third parties or agents will be invalid. Entries that do not comply with these Terms and Conditions (including those containing any false information) will be invalid.

### **The Free Prize Draw**

8. The winner will be drawn at random by an independent judge (the 'Judge') from all complete entries received before the Closing Date.

### **The Prize**

9. There will be 10 prizes, subject to availability and the Foundation's right to substitute a prize of similar value in unforeseen circumstances. The prize is an iPad (the Foundation reserves the right to choose the model). The

Foundation reserves the right to purchase iPads through an external supplier of their choice on behalf of the winner upon their claiming the prize.

10. The Foundation shall be entitled to cancel giving the prize without notice should the winner engage in any inappropriate, illegal or immoral behaviour, use excessive alcohol, artificial stimulants or illegal drugs, or act in any manner which brings or might bring the Foundation or any person or organisation involved in the Free Prize Draw into public disrepute or places any person in distress or danger. The Foundation reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, this Prize Draw with or without prior notice due to reasons outside its control (including, without limitation, in the case of anticipated, suspected or actual fraud).

11. The winners will be notified by 1 October 2017 via the email address provided at the time of entry. The name, country and Award unit (if applicable) of the winner may be published on the Foundation's website. These details can also be obtained by writing to The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Foundation, Award House, 7-11 St Matthew Street, SW1P 2JT, London, The United Kingdom, within 12 months of the Closing Date.

12. The winner must claim the prize within 15 working days of the Foundation sending notification. If the prize is unclaimed after this time, it will lapse and the Foundation may (but shall not be obliged to) offer the unclaimed prize to a runner up selected in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

13. The prize is non-transferable and the winner cannot request any alternative prize (cash or otherwise).

14. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the Foundation reserve the right to (a) substitute the prize with an alternative; and (b) cancel, modify, extend or suspend the Free Prize Draw.

15. All details and other restrictions applying to the prize not specified in these Terms and Conditions shall be determined by the Foundation in its sole discretion.

16. The Foundation reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time on giving notice through its website [www.intaward.org](http://www.intaward.org).

#### **Data Protection**

17. By entering the Free Prize Draw, you consent to the use of your personal data by the Foundation for the purposes of administration of the Free Prize Draw (including publishing your name, country and Award unit (if applicable) if you are the winner) and for any other purposes to which you have consented.

### **Indemnity and Limitation of Liability**

18. To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Foundation excludes its liability for any loss, damage, injury, cost or expense suffered by you, whether directly or indirectly and howsoever caused, in connection with the Free Prize Draw and use of any prize. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall exclude the Foundation's liability for death or personal injury arising from the Foundation's own negligence or any other liability that cannot, as a matter of law, be excluded.

19. You agree to indemnify the Foundation and keep the Foundation indemnified against any loss, damage, injury, cost or expense suffered by the Foundation as a result of your entry in the Free Prize Draw, including (but not limited to) any claim of infringement of intellectual property rights made by any third party.

20. The Foundation shall not be liable for any failure to comply with its obligations where the failure is caused by something outside its reasonable control. Such circumstances shall include, but not be limited to, weather conditions, fire, flood, hurricane, strike, industrial dispute, war, hostilities, political unrest, riots, civil commotion, inevitable accidents, supervening legislation or any other circumstances amounting to force majeure.

### **General**

21. The Judge's decision will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

22. All entries become the property of the Foundation and will not be returned. You acknowledge and agree that you will assign all intellectual property rights in your Free Prize Draw submission and/or any statements made by you regarding the Free Prize Draw or the Foundation.

23. The winner may be required to take part in promotional activity related to the Prize Draw and the winner shall participate in such activity on The Foundation's reasonable request. The winner consents to the use by the Foundation and its related companies and organisations, both before and after the closing date of the Prize Draw for an unlimited time, of the winner's voice, image, photograph and name for publicity purposes (in any medium, including still photographs and films, and on the internet, including any websites hosted by the Foundation and its related partners) and in advertising, marketing or promotional material without additional compensation or prior notice and, in entering the Prize Draw, all entrants consent to the same.

24. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed and construed in accordance with English Law and will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
